[Disobedient Objects](#) opened on 26th July at the V&A, Cromwell Road, London SW7 and runs until 1 February 2015. From Suffragette teapots to protest robots, this exhibition is the first to examine the powerful role of objects in movements for social change. It demonstrates how political activism drives a wealth of design ingenuity and collective creativity that defy standard definitions of art and design.
