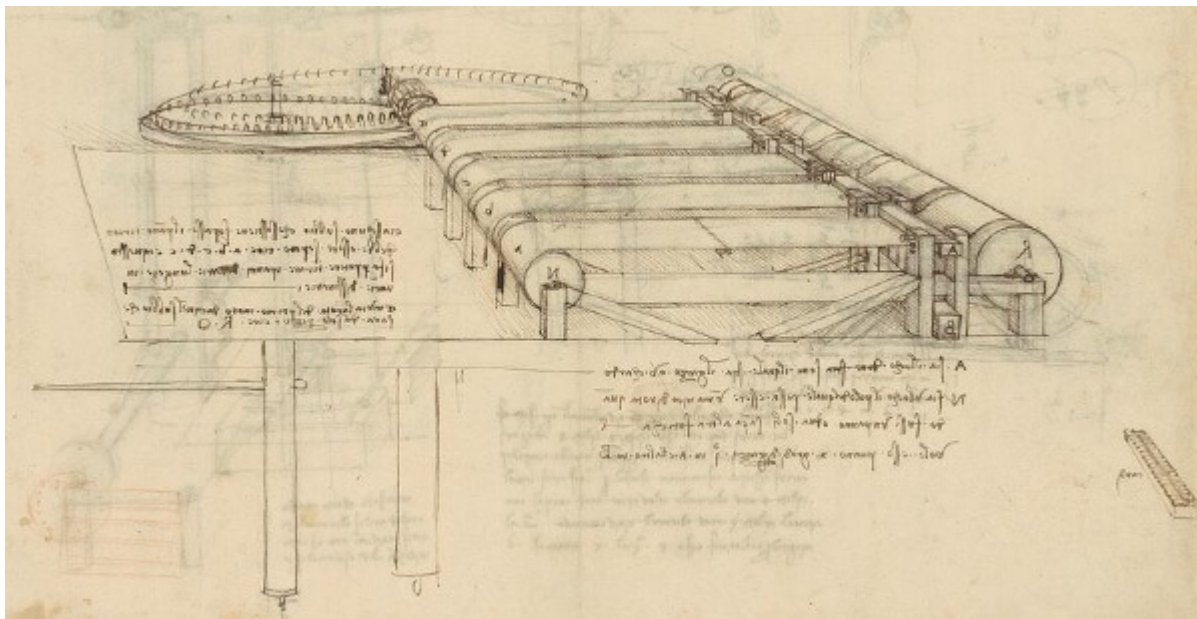


Manufacturing is enjoying a mini-renaissance
