also called “air duster”, “canned air”, “compressed air”, and “dusting gas”, they are used to provide a pressurised blast, knocking loose dust and dirt. Think of them as a portable replacement for an air compressor line. They can be used to blow out biscuit crumbs from a keyboard, clear out computer vents, open up tight apertures in an SMT (surface mount technology) stencil in PCB assembly, and clean critical optical assemblies.
